TOTAL DOG AWARD

Requirements for Total Dog Award

Total Dog competition will be held over two days. The conformation qualifiers are at the HPEBGDC Specialty Show 1 and Show 2 on Saturday evening; and performance qualifiers are at the HPEBGDC Field Trials on Saturday and Sunday. Dogs will not have to earn all Total Dog requirements on the same day. This will apply solely for the HPEBGDC Events. To be eligible for a "Total Dog" award, a dog must meet the following criteria:

1. On Saturday, October 21, 2017, compete in conformation with competition and win one of the following awards: Best Male/Female of Variety, Best Male/Female, Best of Winners, Champion, Reserve Champion, Champion Award of Merit, Grand Champion, Grand Champion Award of Merit, Best of Breed. The following addition to the existing Total Dog Rules regarding conformation competition requirements for the Champion and Grand Champion classes shall apply solely on Saturday, October 21, 2017.

a. Champion Classes. Champion Award of Merit (CAOM) shall count toward competition win when computing a total dog qualifier. The number of Champion Awards of Merit to be awarded

shall be calculated as follows:

- 5-9 dogs in competition – 1 CAOM • 10-14 dogs in competition – 2 CAOM

b. Grand Champion Classes. Grand Award of Merits (GAOM) shall count towards competition when computing a total dog qualifier. The number of Grand Awards of Merit to be awarded shall be calculated as follows:

- 3-4 dogs in competition – 1 GAOM • 5-9 dogs in competition – 2 GAOM

2. On Saturday, October 21, 2017 or Sunday, October 22, 2017, earn a qualifying score in a field performance event. Qualifying scores earned from OPEN or GUN class field performance events will count toward the Total Dog Award. Qualifying scores will include the ranking of PASS or better, earning a TAN or WRT award will not satisfy the qualifying score in a field performance event. Dogs that meet the above requirements will automatically receive a special “Total Dog Qualifier” award.

3. The “Total Dog Winner” award will be awarded based on the performance in show and field events. All recipients of the “Total Dog Qualifier” award will be considered for “Total Dog Winner”. The calculation will consist of the sum of show awards X the sum of field awards, resulting in an overall weekend score. Points will be awarded per the following points schedule.

SHOW HOURS: Official confirmation will begin at 1:00 PM, judging will begin at 4:00 PM on Saturday, October 21, 2017.

Dogs are not required to be at the show until scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Mailed entries must be received by October 1, 2017 to qualify for pre-entry fee. Day of Show Entries will be accepted between the hours of 1:00 PM and 3:00 PM. No Day of Show Entries will be accepted without a valid UKC Registration Number.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. All events are held under the Rules and Regulations of the United Kennel Club, Inc.
2. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs will be allowed on the grounds or in the buildings on the day of a UKC licensed event.
3. UKC, HPEDGDC, their agents, and employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators or by exhibitors and handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians. UKC/HPEBGDC are not responsible for loss, accidents or theft.
4. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
5. No smoking in all buildings and areas designated as such.
6. Exhibitors and dog owners are expected and required to clean up after their own dogs. Any person witnessing a violation of this rule must report it to the Event Committee. The Event Committee may ask any person violating this rule to leave the event grounds. No refund will be made if an exhibitor is asked to leave the grounds.
7. UKC will vigorously support any motel that files a complaint about exhibitors who fail to keep their dogs quiet or to clean up after them. In order that the bad conduct of a few exhibitors does not spoil it for the majority of responsible exhibitors, UKC will take strong disciplinary action against any offenders.
8. UKC encourages exhibitors to present their dogs with the least amount of grooming necessary to enable a Judge to properly compare each dog with the standard of its breed. Dogs should be clean, with nails cut to a length suitable for the dog to perform the work for which it was bred, and with clean teeth. The Judge's determination that this rule has been violated shall be final. UKC enforces rules against artificially altering pigment and coat color, coat texture, and surgical alterations as outlined in the UKC Rules and Regulations.
9. Dogs may not be left unattended when crated in soft mesh crates. No dog may be left in an unlatched or un-zippered crate.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Show grounds will be open to exhibitors at 11:00 a.m. Overnight security is not provided and no dog(s) may be left on the grounds overnight. All times are Central Standard Time.
2. No smoking in all buildings and areas designated as such
3. No admission or parking fees.

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

1. Dogs must be permanently registered with UKC as Epagneul Bretons, have a Temporary Listing (TL) number, or have a Limited Privilege (LP) listing number by the closing date and time in order to enter. No exceptions will be made. Entries for ineligible dogs will be returned.
2. An un-entered dog may not be substituted for an entered dog.

SUBMITTING ENTRIES

1. Entries may be submitted on the Official UKC Entry Form included with this Premium List or on any current official UKC Entry Form. Downloaded copies or photocopies of these forms may be used as well.
2. Advance entries may be mailed or hand-delivered to the Show Secretary.
3. Mailed entries received without fees will not be accepted.
4. Advance entries must be received by the closing date and time: midnight on October 1, 2017.

PAYMENT

1. Payment may be made by cash, check, or money order. No entry will be accepted without payment.

2. Make checks and money orders payable to HPEBGDC. Checks and money orders must be payable in U.S. funds. Cash will be in US currency.
3. Post-dated checks or returned checks do not constitute valid entry fees. HPEBGDC will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check or money order. Exhibitors who repeatedly submit invalid entry fees may be put on a CASH ONLY basis.

REFUNDS

1. No refund of entry fees will be made for entries cancelled after the Advance Entry deadline.
2. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Event Committee.
3. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the host organization it is impossible to open or to complete a show or trial, no refund of entry fee will be made.
4. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries before processing. If a duplicate entry is processed, however, no refund will be made.
5. If, in the opinion of the host club, the well-being of dogs, exhibitors or spectators is at risk due to extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, or extreme heat, the host club may cancel or stop a show or trial before completion. No refunds will be made in such cases.

ENTRY CONFIRMATION

Written confirmation of entries will be made by mail (or email, if provided) as soon as practicable after receipt of Advanced Entries. If you do not receive your confirmation by the Saturday preceding this event, please notify the Show Secretary, Julie Bollin at bentrivbretons@gmail.com or (309) 333-6359. Receipt of e-mail entries will be acknowledged immediately by return e-mail but this does not constitute confirmation of the entry. Entry will be confirmed upon receipt of the appropriate entry fees.

CLASS CHANGE/CORRECTION OF ENTRY

1. Owners are responsible for the accuracy of information in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. Owners and exhibitors are responsible for correcting any errors in their entry.
2. Dogs that, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a title after the closing of entries may be transferred from the entered class to another class for which the dog is now eligible, provided that a request for transfer is made in writing to the show secretary not later than half an hour prior to the start of regular judging at the show.
3. All other corrections to entries must be made in writing to the show secretary not later than half an hour prior to the start of regular judging at the show.

ARMBANDS

One armband will be assigned to each entered dog for all shows and trials in which the dog is entered for the weekend. Armbands can be picked up from the Show Secretary on the day of the show. If you lose your armband or it gets destroyed you can see the Show Secretary for a replacement.

CONFIRMING OF DOGS

Dogs may be confirmed to be within the Breed Standard in accordance with CEB-US Confirming Guidelines PRIOR to the show at 4:00 PM. An application for *Performance of Evaluation for Basic Conformation and for Publication of Conformation Rating* must be completed; a copy of the dog's UKC Pedigree or Easy Entry Card MUST be provided; and the applicable fee must be presented before the confirming will be conducted. Preference will be given to applications that are submitted in advance so you are strongly encouraged to submit your application to Robert Olson, P.O. Box 251, Brookston, IN 47923. Late requests will be handled on a first come/time availability basis the day of the event.

- 1. All entries must be submitted on the current "Official UKC Entry Form". You may use one entry form to enter the same dog in more than one show on the same weekend.
2. Use a separate entry form for each dog entered in a club's event.
3. Mail all completed entry forms to the Event Secretary listed under the event, unless otherwise specified. Make checks payable to host club.
4. We want you to keep the points earned at UKC Licensed events. Important things to remember:
- Dog not UKC registered? Apply for a Temporary Listing Number (TL) online at www.ukcdogs.com or call the Dog Events Department at (269) 343-9020. (TL fees are non-refundable, non-transferable and do not apply to the cost of permanent registration.)
- All dogs entering UKC events must be permanently registered, have a valid Temporary Listing Number, or a Performance Listing/Limited Privilege number.
- All entry forms must be completed and signed. Incorrect information submitted on the entry form may invalidate your wins.
- To be eligible to enter into the Breeder/Handler class, you must be one of the breeders of record, or a member of the immediate family of one of the breeders of record. Immediate family includes: spouse, parent, step-parent, child, step-child, sibling, grandchild, or in-law, so long as the handler is not a professional handler as defined by UKC Rules and Regulations.

The overall rating of dogs receiving a rating greater than Insufficient shall be recorded in the Association's database, and published on the CEB-US Official Website and/or semi-annual Magazine.
Owner's Certification/Authorization:
